


# Milking Area

   & 2:30 p.m.
- over 500 jersey cows provides beautifully creamy milk



- jersey cows
- known for their rich, creamy and distinctive yellowish milk.
- only fed non-GMO food and mostly eat fresh pasture
- has a lower lactose (sugar) content with more protein, calcium, minerals and fat






Cow's Features

 Strong body leading to delicious meat

Large head and ears,
 broad forehead




















- Largest animal on Earth up to 33
  meters long (like 3 buses!)
- Weighs 200 tons equal to 30 adult elephants
- Heart = size of a car
- Tongue = space for 50 people to stand on



- Population: Only 10,000-25,000 left
- Threats: overhunting, ship noise, ocean waste
- Protection: Global fishing bans now in place
- Every small action—like reducing ocean waste—helps them survive








### The Twelve Apostles

#### Fun Facts About Little Penguins

Penguin Crossing

- Smallest species
- Height: 30-33 cm Weight: ~1 kg
- Spend 80% of their lives at sea
- Return to the same nesting sites every evening
- Their blue-gray feathers help to protect them from predators
